Trampolining Gala in Oxted

The Saturn V Gym Club hosted another of their trampoline competitions to showcase upcoming talent in the area on Saturday, at the new regular venue of Moor House School in Hurst Green, Oxted. The first ever Novices Gold Medal was won by Oliver Riley (10), scoring highest for both his level 6 routines, while Adam Craggs (16) and Willis Langley (13) took home Silver and Bronze medals for their routines at grades 7 and 5.

There were also impressive displays from many youngsters at the Grade 8, 9 and 10 levels from other schools.

The spectators from the gallery gave resounding applause to all the athletes who competed in great spirit and with superb ability. The medal winners (pictured) were proud to have earned such high scores from tough competition.

The afternoon was enjoyed by all present, with many people commenting on how they are looking forward to the next competition later in the year. Horley coach Adam Reynolds concurred, adding: "No doubt there will be even more interest in the event then, and even more to applaud, with each gold medal winner now training for the next levels' event. I think the coaches are looking forward to it as much as the children!"
