### **Residential Care Workers (1 x full-time post & 1 x 23 hour per week post) £20,916 - £22,790 (full-time working salary)**

Responsible for providing the highest levels of care and support for our students as outlined in their Education and Healthcare Plans. You will be an appointed key-worker providing a safe and secure environment for all the students in our care, both individually and as part of a team with the overall objective of supporting students to achieve and maximise their potential.

A relevant NVQ level 3 qualification is essential plus a commitment to undertake role specific training as required.

A Night-time Supervisor is required to work two nights regularly per week, between the hours of 22:00 and 07:00. Duties include:

- Co-ordinating a handover from Healthcare/ Senior staff at the commencement of each duty;
- Ensuring the building is secure;
- Carrying out hourly checks on students throughout the night, as well as responding to alarm calls; this includes basic medical checks with any relevant training provided.

Suitable candidates will be able to demonstrate experience in a similar capacity and must hold an appropriate NVQ level 3 qualification or equivalent.
